Discover the beauties of Colombia, Eastern Canada or New Zealand

Adventures by Disney is expanding its options. Itineraries are growing, opening the eyes of travelers who are eager to cross off new places visited. Colombia, Eastern Canada's Maritime Provinces and New Zealand add action, adventure and good times to its 2024 tours.

Colombia headlines the new destinations. Its people and cultures sparked the imaginations of Disney storytellers, who created the Walt Disney Animation Studios' Academy Award-winning film "Encanto." Disney travel experts have curated a unique adventure filled with discoveries and experiences inspired by the film.

Guests will be immersed in the diverse cultures and landscapes of Colombia. Receive a taste of local cuisine and discover its wondrous characteristics and beauty. Lush, green landscapes with towering wax palm trees and a kaleidoscope of butterflies, family recipes, traditional customs and music will surround guests as they embrace the splendor of the second-most biodiverse country in the world.

Highlights of the eight-day, seven-night itinerary include:

- Visiting the capital city of Bogotá.
- Enjoying Colombian coffee and visiting a coffee farm in the Coffee Region to see the process. The nearby town of Salento is part of the inspiration for the setting of "Encanto."
- Exploring the city of Cartagena, which inspired the film's colorful architecture and fabrics. The Afro-Caribbean influence is central to "Encanto" and prominent

in the city.

- Trekking the dry forest near Proyecto Titi, an organization to the preservation of the cotton-top tamarins.
- Snorkeling among the Rosario Islands, a collection of 27 islands home to more than 1,300 species of marine animals, vibrantly colored fish and plants.

Meanwhile, Canada's Atlantic coast and Maritime Provinces of Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island include an itinerary filled with unforgettable activities. Celebrate the outdoors with experiences that surround families with the region's

picturesque rivers, beaches, ocean coasts and gulfs.

The eight-day, seven-night trip includes:

- Visiting an authentic maple-syrup farm in Nova Scotia, learning about tree tapping and the process that brings syrup from tree to table, and sampling the locally tapped product.
- Discovering the Wood Island Lighthouse. It has served the community for more than 150 years. Junior adventures will enjoy making kites and flying them as the breeze comes off the seas.
- Exploring Avonlea Village, the

fictitious community central to Anne of Green Gables stories and enjoying tea with a descendent of author Lucy Maud Montgomery's family.

- Walking the ocean floor at the Bay of Fundy, an onboard fisherman's feast, horseback riding, gazing at the stars during a bonfire, biking, canoeing and kayaking.

New Zealand is a visual delight. Stunning scenery, blue waters, snow-capped mountains, volcanic-sand beaches and tropical rainforests provide an incredible and diverse experience. The 12-day, 11-night itinerary takes guests to vibrant cities and small towns. Activities include:

- Participating in the America's Cup Experience in Auckland, the "City of Sails".
- Sharing an authentic Hangi dinner with a local family to experience the Indigenous Maori culture.
- Marveling at thousands of glow worms illuminating an underground cave among limestone formations.
- Touring the National Kiwi Hatchery, a facility renowned for its kiwi-bird conservation program.
- Gazing at the dramatic geysers that dot the landscape at the Te Puia Geothermal Park, also home to the largest geyser in the Southern Hemisphere.
- Traveling via the TransAlpine Train upwards into the Southern Alps.
