REAL ID Extended to May 7, 2025

The Department of Homeland Security extended the REAL ID deadline to May 7, 2025. The REAL ID Act established minimum security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards and prohibits Federal agencies from accepting for official purposes licenses and identification cards from states that do not meet these standards. Beginning May 7, 2025, every state and territory resident will need to present a REAL ID compliant license/ID, or another acceptable form of ID for boarding commercial aircraft, accessing Federal facilities and entering nuclear plants. The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) considers a current passport or military ID acceptable identification for boarding an aircraft. Unforgettable road trips in Pennsylvania Hop in your vehicle and explore the Keystone State

irplanes, cruise ships and worldly destinations often are associated with choosing your next vacation. But sometimes, nothing beats a road trip.

Road trips can be simple, less expensive and more relaxing. Hop in your vehicle, motorhome or pull your camper to places few people consider, but those who do are thankful they did.

Options abound. Nationwide, national parks, lakes and mountain regions quickly come to mind. States like Montana, Utah, Wyoming and Colorado rank high in popularity, but it might be more fitting to stay close to home

Pennsylvania frequently is overlooked by travelers in search of a road trip. Its diversity and uniqueness make it an ideal place plan your next trip.

Locations to visit are in abundance. Here are places to consider:

Bushkill Falls – Coined the "Niagara of Pennsylvania," it's home to eight waterfalls, dozens of trails and diverse wildlife. It's an ideal location for birdwatching, hiking, fishing and exploration. The site is located deep within the Pocono Mountains.

Downtown Philadelphia
