

REAL ID Extended to May 7, 2025

The Department of Homeland Security extended the REAL ID deadline to May 7, 2025. The REAL ID Act established minimum security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards and prohibits Federal agencies from accepting for official purposes licenses and identification cards from states that do not meet these standards. Beginning May 7,

2025, every state and territory resident will need to present a REAL ID compliant license/ID, or another acceptable form of ID for boarding commercial aircraft, accessing Federal facilities and entering nuclear plants. The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) considers a current passport or military ID acceptable identification for boarding an aircraft. Cold weather can be unkind to battery Take steps to reduce chances it leaves you in bad spot

old weather affects your battery more than any engine component. Batteries are filled with fluid, most of which is water. They are susceptible to freezing if a battery is not fully charged.

Cold also thickens engine oil, forcing the battery to work harder when starting the car. Your vehicle's battery loses approximately 35% of its efficiency when the temperature dips below freezing and nearly as much as 60% of its efficiency when the temperature falls below zero.

Slow cranking is a common sign your battery might be getting weak but diagnosing battery problems can be tricky. Your battery terminals could be calcified, or a parasitic draw, often from a mobile device, is draining its power. Unplug your phone and charger when you don't need them.

AAA Battery Service offers fast, accurate and convenient mobile-battery testing and replacement. State-of-theart diagnostic equipment will confirm whether your battery will hold a charge, or if the problem lies deeper in the electrical system. The service is included with your AAA membership.

If a new battery is needed, you can purchase one and have it installed on the spot. AAA Battery Service vehicles carry batteries compatible with 90% of cars, SUVs and light trucks on the road. And each AAA-branded battery is covered by

Our Instant Quote battery-price calculator on AAA.com will give you member and nonmember pricing for your vehicle's battery, reflecting your exclusive AAA discount. In addition, every battery that AAA replaces is safely recycled to protect the environment.

AAA also recommends you take these special precautions with your vehicle's battery this winter:

- Have the starting and charging systems tested every year.
- On frigid days, shut off the heater fans, radio and other devices before cranking the engine.
- Inspect the battery cables, posts and fasteners. Cable corrosion prevents power from flowing freely from the battery, reducing the power available to start the car. Clean the battery terminals with a wire brush or battery-cleaner spray.

- Avoid short trips. It can take as long as 30 minutes for a car battery to fully charge. Short trips can diminish the amount of reserve capacity.
- Preventative measures such as garaging your vehicles or using a battery charger like the AAA Battery Tender – can help extend a battery's lifespan.

Winter also means fewer hours of daylight and increased use of lights, wipers and heating, all of which extract a heavy toll on your battery. The more electrical devices in the car – such as electronic fuel-injection systems, power windows and infotainment systems – the more power the battery should have.

Your best defense against failure is a fully charged battery and adequate cold-cranking amps – 500-700 – depending on the type of engine in your vehicle.

Winter driving puts your skills to the test

inter-driving season is most challenging to our nerves, vehicles and skills. The scenario is too familiar. Temperatures drop, snow falls and ice forms. It's a losing trifecta.

Slippery roads cause many of us to shudder behind the wheel. Our familiar commutes just became a treacherous nightmare.

Snow and ice, meanwhile, aren't the only culprits. Fewer hours of daylight obscure our vision and the sun's glare reflecting off the snow can have a blinding effect.

Rapidly changing weather conditions make it essential drivers remain alert and vigilant. Here are 10 winter-driving tips to help make the experience safer and less stressful:

- Monitor weather and travel conditions. Know the difference between a Winter Storm Watch and Winter Weather Advisory, and how they could impact your plans.
- Think cautiously if you must drive in wintry conditions. Make sure your fuel tank is full. Clear all snow from the hood, roof, windows and lights of your vehicle. Clear windows of fog before driving. Make sure the windshield-wiper fluid is full and wipers are in good condition.
- Not all vehicles respond similarly to icy, slippery roads. Familiarize yourself with the vehicle's braking

- system, tire tractions and all-wheeldrive systems. Avoid using cruise control in wintry conditions.
- Don't panic if your vehicle becomes trapped in a storm or snowbank. Avoid overexertion and exposure and stay in the vehicle. Run the motor sparingly and keep fresh air in the vehicle. Stay moving and don't fall asleep. Stay alert for traffic and first-responders.
- Try to avoid secondary roads and drive with caution. Measure your speed to road and weather conditions. Avoid passing other vehicles when road conditions are at their worst. Bridges, ramps and overpasses freeze first.
- Plan your route and make sure someone knows which way you will be traveling, your destination and expected arrival time, especially when driving long distances. Report a safe arrival.
- Leave room for maintenance vehicles and plows. Remain at least 200 feet behind them.
- Carry a winter-survival kit in the trunk or storage area of your vehicle.
 Fully charge your cell phone; and always keep a road map, flashlight, first-aid kit, blanket and shovel in your vehicle.
- And most importantly, drive slowly. Take your time. The posted speed limits are meant for dry pavement.

Charging EVs in cold requires preparation

uestions abound regarding the purchasing of an electric vehicle. One of the more common is how do colder temperatures affect charging and mileage range.

The driving capacities of all vehicles – no matter the source of power – suffer during the seasons when our weather patterns reach their coldest conditions. The U.S. Department of Energy found that fuel economy suffers by 15-24% in gas-powered vehicles and the ranges of EVs drop by roughly 39%.

Driving and charging an EV in colder weather has its nuances, according to the University of Michigan. Temperatures below 40 degrees can reduce charging power, but with preparation and planning, an EV will meet your needs year-round.

Here are tips to keep an EV running smoothly during the winter:

Charging may take longer – The vehicle controls the charging rate, not the charger. Lower temperatures result in an EV's software reducing its charging power to avoid stressing the battery. The Idaho National Laboratory found that at 32 degrees, an EV battery absorbed 36% less energy that when the battery was charged the same amount of time at 77 degrees. It's important to plan for longer charge times when temperatures drop.

Pay attention to overnight changes in your EV's range – Be aware of overnight low temperatures. Cold temperatures overnight can lower an EV's driving range by an average of 20%, according to the Norwegian Automobile Federation. Pay attention to the vehicle's console display. Some EVs can predict these range reductions during extreme temperatures.

Plan your charges – Expect to stop at public-charging stations to avoid finding yourself with a limited range. The Electrify America mobile app assists drivers to easily navigate to nearby ultrafast charging stations and see which chargers are available.

Park indoors when you can – Parking an EV in a garage with higher indoor temperatures can help the battery charge more quickly and hold that charge longer.

Understand your EV's cold-weather features – Some EVs have preconditioned features that allow drivers to program or manually warm the battery to more optimal temperatures. This process uses battery power to provide a warming effect, but it can make the battery more efficient while maximizing driving range.

By understanding your EV and its charging needs, particularly during colder weather, you'll be better prepared to rely on your EV, no matter when and where you are driving.

Don't assume other driver will stop after crash What motorists should do if they're victims of a hit-and-run

ou're driving on a busy highway when you notice a speeding car coming up quickly behind you. It's zigzagging between lanes, narrowly missing other cars. Before you can react, it catches up with you – and clips your car's rear end.

Momentarily stunned, you ask if your passengers are OK, and you start to pull to the side of the road. Then, you get a second shock: The perpetrator is racing away, clearly with no intention of stopping to exchange insurance information.

That's when you realize you're the victim of a hit-and-run driver. At this point, you know the normal post-crash procedures don't necessarily apply. But how can you make sure your insurance claim goes smoothly? Keep the following tips in mind:

DO pull over to a safe place and write down as much information about the other driver and the collision as you can remember. Some or all of the other driver's license plate would be great. But even the other car's make, model and color can help, along with the direction it was headed and any damage the car might have sustained.

DO take pictures of your car and

the area in which the crash occurred if it is safe to do so. Time-stamped photos of the road and weather conditions, as well as traffic flow, can assist with your claim.

DO ask any witnesses to describe what they saw, and write down their testimony, names and contact information, so that your claims adjuster can contact them, if necessary.

DO call the police. If the damage is minor or no one is injured, the police might not come to the crash scene. However, your auto insurance policy might require you to notify the police of any hit-and-run accident. If that's the case, be sure to file a police report, whether at the scene,

by phone or at the police station.

DO report the collision accurately when you call your insurer. Intentionally misrepresenting facts about an accident could lead to a suspicion of fraud. Insurance companies are able to easily recognize whether a vehicle came into contact with another vehicle and whether it was in motion when it sustained damage.

In many cases, either the victim, a witness or a surveillance camera can supply enough information for the police to find the fleeing driver. If a hit-and-run driver is caught, he or she could face these serious penalties: fines up to \$10,000 and prison time, depending on the severity of the damage or injuries caused by the crash. Plus, the DMV could put points on the driver's license; the driver's insurer, if he or she has one, could cancel coverage; and anyone injured in the accident could sue.

DON'T play detective and chase the other car. You might be tempted to try to get the license-plate number for your claim, but that could result in unsafe driving and worsen the situation. Remember: As long as you have the appropriate coverage, your insurance company should assist in repairing your car.

Annual new vehicle costs rise above \$12K Record prices, 90% increase in finance rates drive numbers

he yearly cost to drive a motor vehicle continues to rise.

AAA's Your Driving Costs

a data source for expenses associated with owning and operating a new vehicle – finds that the average cost of owning and operating a new vehicle in 2023 increased significantly. The annual expense of \$12,182 – or \$1,015 monthly – is a sharp increase from 2022, when the average cost topped at \$10,728 – \$894 monthly.

"It's important for car buyers to clearly understand the costs associated with owning a new vehicle," said Greg Brannon, AAA's director of automotive research. "Due to global supply-chain issues and constrained inventory of new vehicles, car prices rose dramatically in 2022. And while the situation continues to improve, the spillover effects are keeping prices high."

The overall average manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP) of new vehicles in 2023 increased to \$34,976 – an annual increase of \$1,575 from the previous year. It's important to note that MSRP does not always correspond to a consumer's actual purchase price and might vary depending on demand. A higher sticker price directly impacted finance costs, with vehicles boasting an average annual finance of \$1,253 – a 90% increase from the previous year.

The change in the annual cost of owning a new vehicle also is likely driven by:

- Depreciation, which is the difference between the car's value upon purchase and the value of the car when sold. According to 2023's YDC projections, new vehicles are expected to depreciate by an average of \$4,538 per year over five years of ownership up 22% from 2022.
- The jump in new-vehicle prices compared to used-vehicle values that have experienced a decline in the past year.

 Automakers have focused on producing more oversized, luxurious and expensive vehicles loaded with extra features that increase prices even more.

Compared to 2022, fuel ranked among one of the higher annual-cost categories. The average cost per mile in 2023 decreased roughly 2 cents per mile. Meanwhile, the cost of charging EVs increased by nearly 2 cents per kWh from 2022. It went from 13.9 cents per kWh to 15.8 cents. The increase is likely accounted for by higher-than-expected inflation, according to the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Given their size, fuel economy and prices, it should come as no surprise that half-ton pickups have the highest average driving costs among all vehicle categories covered in the YDC study. Pickup trucks excel at hauling and towing, although many buyers don't use them for these purposes. Potential buyers should be aware that the unique capabilities of pickups come at a high cost of more than \$1 per mile.

The pickup market has slowed over the past 12 months, with gas prices trending higher and financial costs climbing.

"The once popular pickup truck is now seeing a slight decline in demand as these vehicles have become increasingly expensive, rivaling the price of many luxury cars," said Brannon. "As interest rates continue to climb, this adds a layer of expense per month that consumers should consider when shopping for their next vehicle."

Tips From a AAA Travel Advisor: Ebonee Hiner

Utah's Mighty Five live up to their billing Natural wonders, adventure abound on this epic journey

'm an outdoorsy type of person, so it's no surprise that Utah and the state's MIGHTY FIVE moved to first place on my travel list after

my trip this past November. I've been a travel advisor for six years, and this adventure took my breath away!

As soon as we arrived in Salt Lake City, our 12-passenger van and driver guide took us to Antelope Island, 90 minutes from

town. We visited the Great Salt Lake, the largest of its namesake, and saw bison roaming in their natural habitat. Later, we toured Salt Lake City, including the Utah Capitol building, and world-famous Mormon Tabernacle.

Day 2, we drove four hours to Canyonlands National Park in southeastern Utah. It's known for its dramatic desert landscape carved by the Colorado River. We saw Mesa Arch, one of the West's most photographed landforms, and Grand Point View Trail – named because when you look over the cliff, the rocks look like a dead horse. Another notable area was the Needles, the remote Canyons of the Maze.

Day 3, we discovered the mighty

Arches National Park, a red-rock wonderland of eroded sandstone. The landscape has contrasting colors, landforms and textures unlike any other, with 2,000 natural-stone arches, soaring pinnacles, massive rock fins and giant balanced rocks. I chose a sixmile, round-trip hike to Delicate Arch. It was steep and took about 90 minutes uphill. My travel tip is to get there early enough to see the sunrise.

Day 4, we drove by the Moab Petroglyphs from the Native American Anasazi tribe, towering 60-70 feet off the road. All of this on our way to Goblin Valley State Park, where we saw thousands of hoodoos, referred to locally as goblins, which are formations of mushroom-shaped rock pinnacles, some as tall as several yards.

We ended the day at Capitol Reef, so named by the early settlers who thought the domes on the rock formations looked like the Capitol building in D.C. I hiked the 1.2-mile trail to Hickman Natural Bridge – a 125-foot-

tall formation that spans 133 feet! Our group indulged and spent the night at the Capitol Reef Resort, one of the Top 20 Resorts in Utah honored by Travel + Leisure in 2023. You can stay in a luxurious stand-alone cabin, relax in a teepee or go glamping in their Conestoga Wagon rooms onsite.

Day 5, we drove Highway 12 – a 123-mile scenic byway designated an All-American Road to Bryce Canyon – known for its crimson hoodoos or spire-shaped rocks. At Bryce, our tour guide gave us two options for a longer or shorter hike. I took the challenge and hiked two hours on the Queens Garden trail to the Navajo Trail loop, a 32-story hike, 7,000 feet in elevation.

Every day kept getting better and Day 6 was no exception. Zion National Park is distinguished by the canyon's steep red cliffs. Some trails were closed due to falling rocks. Our tour guide told us which ones were open. Zion has a shuttle system, so you start at the visitors center and the shuttle goes to all eight trails. We did the Narrows on the last stop. Then after a one-hour hike, we got back on the shuttle to the next trail.

My travel tips are pack good hiking shoes that are already broken-in, layer your clothes. It was cold in the mornings, and warm in the afternoon. And have your camera ready. Everything is SO PHOTOGENIC! And it's OK to do the easier hikes!

Las Vegas museums entertain and educate Galleries offer informative settings throughout the town

xtravagant resorts, massive casinos and lights bright enough to take down a power grid have symbolized Las Vegas for decades. But there's much more to the City That Never Sleeps than the sounds of ringing slot machines and decadent neon signs.

Las Vegas is home to museums. They're educational and comical, unique and irresistible, and an ideal way to avoid the afternoon heat and gaming tables.

The galleries carry outrageous themes that range from pinball machines to monsters. There's a children's museum; a haunted one, too. And who could imagine a Las Vegas that didn't pay homage to the King of Rock and Roll?

The King's Ransom Museum can be found on Fremont Street at Binion's Gambling Hall & Hotel. A variety of Elvis' cherished possessions are on display, making it one of the biggest exclusive accumulations of his treasures outside Graceland.

Those interested in the history of the U.S.'s most ruthless gangsters should visit the Mob Museum. It chronicles the connection between the mafia and law authority by presenting shows and antiques. There's even a Wall of Shame that highlights a legendary group of criminals.

Sail back in time at the Titanic The

Artifact Exhibition Las Vegas. A 17-display exhibition hall brims with curios and diversions of the Titanic, a cruise ship that sank in the Atlantic Ocean more than a century ago. The museum includes shows, ancient pieces and reproductions of ship areas like the Grand Staircase, a first-class cabin, the Verandah Café and the boilers. Unfortunately, Leonardo DiCaprio and Kate Winslet will not be available to sign autographs.

The Pinball Hall of Fame is comprised of ... well ... pinball machines. More than 2,000 of them in working condition are available to be played to avoid going "full tilt" at the Texas Hold'em table.

The Ground Zero theater is the primary attraction at the National Atomic Testing Museum. The hall takes guests through the historical backdrop of nuclear testing in Nevada from 1951 to present day. The theater allows guests to

encounter a reenacted bomb test, strolling them through the course of events from the bomb's creation to showing them how to survive a nuclear blast.

Discovery Children's Museum is considered one of the best galleries in Las Vegas. It offers a range of exhibits and programs to encourage kids from all backgrounds to participate in exciting and engaging experiences.

Signs that once lit up the town are on display at Neon Museum and Boneyard. It houses the greatest exhibit of neon signage in the nation. Stroll through the Neon Boneyard in the evening to encounter Las Vegas' most famous signs.

The Las Vegas Natural History Museum focuses on dinosaurs and marine life. Guests also can experience an Egyptian demonstration, focusing on the life of Tutankhamun – aka King Tut.

Antagonistic spirits are rumored to be wandering through Zak Bagans' the Haunted Museum. Hoover Dam Museu terrifying collection of

Stormy conditions can cause problemsVital steps to follow should rain cancel your flight

here's nothing like these major storms to make us think, "What would I do if?" And since storms that shut down air

space and lay waste to entire regions can happen any time of the year, here's my checklist to consider when the next big storm comes around:

Always try to get out ahead of the storm – With an impending weath-

er event, airlines will waive any fees associated with changing your trip. For instance, American Airlines once announced three days before a recent threatening storm that it would rebook people for free. Only for the dates affected, of course, but take them up on it. I know a lot of people, once they're on vacation, don't want to cut things short. But trust me, just cut your vacation short and get out. Don't be the family that's stranded somewhere unfamiliar.

Follow your airline on social media – I can't stress enough how important it is when you travel to have Instagram or X (formerly Twitter) for updates and alerts, as well as getting answers to your

direct questions. Airlines have pulled a lot of their customer service from their phone banks to social media but not everyone is on social media. You could receive a much faster response than if you call. This is more important if you're already at the airport and your flight is canceled. It's sometimes possible to get rebooked via social media more quickly

than if you wait in line with the 150 other people whose flights are canceled or called the airlines' toll-free number.

Use Gethuman.com – It's a handy website to visit when plugging in those toll-free contact numbers into your phone. Enter the company and it will tell you what number to keep pressing to get a representative.

There's nothing worse than seeing your cell phone battery drop as you navigate through 10 minutes of prompts.

Book an airport hotel as a safety net -If you chance it and choose to stay put, make a hotel reservation as a safety net in case flights get canceled. At the very least have the nearby hotel numbers ready to go, so you can call immediately if you need to. And be sure to note their local number, not the 1-800 number. If you make your flight, then congratulations. Many hotels will likely waive the 24-hour cancellation fee since they will have about 200 other people interested. Plan C: If it's safe and makes sense to drive, stay out of what will be a storm zone, then book a car rental. There's no cancelation fee and that could be your last chance out of the area.

Always stay calm – As stressful as this situation can be, it won't be better if everyone is venting their frustrations. No one sits hoping for a major storm to impact vacations or work days, and you're all on the same side, even if it doesn't feel like it. If you need to, walk away for a bit to just breathe before pushing forward.

Know when to stay put – All that said, sometimes the safest option is to stay exactly where you are and wait out a storm. If you've weighed out all your plans and backup plans for getting home and things still seem unsafe, stay

night. It results in a richer and more fulfilling small-cruise experience.
